<p><b>6. Description:</b></p> <p>The TL 9000 Audit Day Requirements has been updated to version 7.0. The changes are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Modified Section 6 to indicate how:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Mandatory Documents are applied for multi-site organizations</li> <li>b. Rounding is applied only AFTER all audit day calculations are completed; and</li> <li>c. Removed measurement audit days for sites that do not collect, validate, and report measurements.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Modified Section 8 to clarify campus.</li> <li>3. Replaced Section 10 to indicate no reductions are allowed beyond IAF Mandatory Documents.</li> </ol>	
<p><b>7. Comments:</b></p> <p>The mandatory effective date of the new chart is September 01, 2023. <b>The minimum time for all audits conducted on or after that date, whether part of an existing or new contract or quote, shall use the R7.0 document.</b> With agreement between the CB and the organization, the new document may be used immediately.</p>
